

## Arthur Township Exemption Certificate Policy

Section 1, Subdivision 14 of the Arthur Township Subdivision Ordinance allows for certain parcel land splits to be exempt from some or all of the provisions of this ordinance.

It is to be the policy of Arthur Township to employ this method only when the proposed subdivision complies with all other provisions of the Arthur Township zoning and subdivision ordinances.

The request for an Exemption Certificate shall be given to the Zoning Administrator 30 days prior to the granting of the certificate.

When the exemption request has been reviewed by the Zoning Administrator, it shall be forward to the Arthur Town Board along with his recommendation. The Board will review the request and approve or deny the Exemption Certificate.

After the Town Board has made their final decision, the ZA will notify the applicant of the approval or denial and issue the Exemption Certificate if it is approved by the Town Board.
