

OPEN FORUM POLICY GUIDELINES
for
ARTHUR TOWNSHIP

The Arthur Town Board offers two Open Forums (Public Comment) at each regular meeting for citizens to provide information or comment directly to the Board. The first will be for items on the agenda only. You will have to state what item on the agenda you are addressing.

The Board Chairman will limit the time available in the Forum to **THREE (3)** minutes per speaker, so the regular business of the township can be completed in a timely manner. Personal attacks on individuals and other disruptive behavior will not be allowed. When the Town Board recognizes this behavior, you will be asked to leave immediately. Law enforcement will be called if you do not comply with this order. Possible charges may be disorderly conduct and/or disrupting a government meeting.

Concerns raised during the Forum regarding township issues will be noted by the Board and assigned at that time to an Administrative or Board Committee for review. If reasonable and appropriate, a response date for Board comment on the concern or issue will be identified.
